

## **Workshop: Strengthening the One Pacific Programme (OPP) for GCF Resubmission**

### **Workshop Objective**

To collectively address Green Climate Fund (GCF) screening comments and agree on technical improvements required for resubmission of the Climate Information and Early Warning Systems – One Pacific Programme (OPP).

### **Expected Outcomes**

- Agreement on country-level gap framing
- Pacific locally led implementation approach
- Complementarity with WRP & existing GCF projects
- Sustainable financing & private sector pathways
- Implementation and absorptive capacity approach
- Clear revision directions for OPP resubmission

### **Workshop Programme**

#### **Session 1 – Setting the Context (09:00 – 09:30)**

Opening and purpose setting, presentation on GCF screening outcome, and clarification of resubmission pathway.

#### **Session 2 – Country Ownership & Gap Analysis (09:30 – 10:30)**

Directors discuss existing national CIEWS systems, critical gaps, investments to scale, and locally led implementation approaches. Output: Agreement on country gap template and NMHS-led investment framing.

#### **Break (10:30 – 10:45)**

#### **Session 3 – Complementarity & Regional Architecture (10:45 – 11:45)**

Technical mapping exercise validating alignment between OPP and existing regional initiatives including WRP, GCF projects, CREWS, SOFF and bilateral investments. Output: Complementarity matrix and positioning of OPP as scaling platform.

#### **Session 4 – Sustainability & Financing Innovation (11:45 – 12:30)**

Discussion on sustainable financing, private sector engagement, revenue generation opportunities and maintenance financing mechanisms. Output: Inputs for blended finance narrative.



**Session 5 – Implementation & Absorptive Capacity (12:30 – 13:00)**

Discussion on regional versus national implementation roles, workforce constraints and shared technical facilities. Output: Agreed implementation model and capacity assurance inputs.

**Session 6 – Way Forward & Director Endorsement (13:00 – 13:30)**

Directors endorse priority revisions, submission timelines, drafting arrangements and resubmission roadmap.
