- Improve access to climate information by strengthening observation and monitoring systems, research, modelling, and prediction.
- Enhance the capacity of ACP regions to generate and apply tailored climate information and products.
- Enhance climate-informed decision-making in ACP regions by bridging the gap between climate science and policy and mainstreaming climate services into regional and national policy processes.
